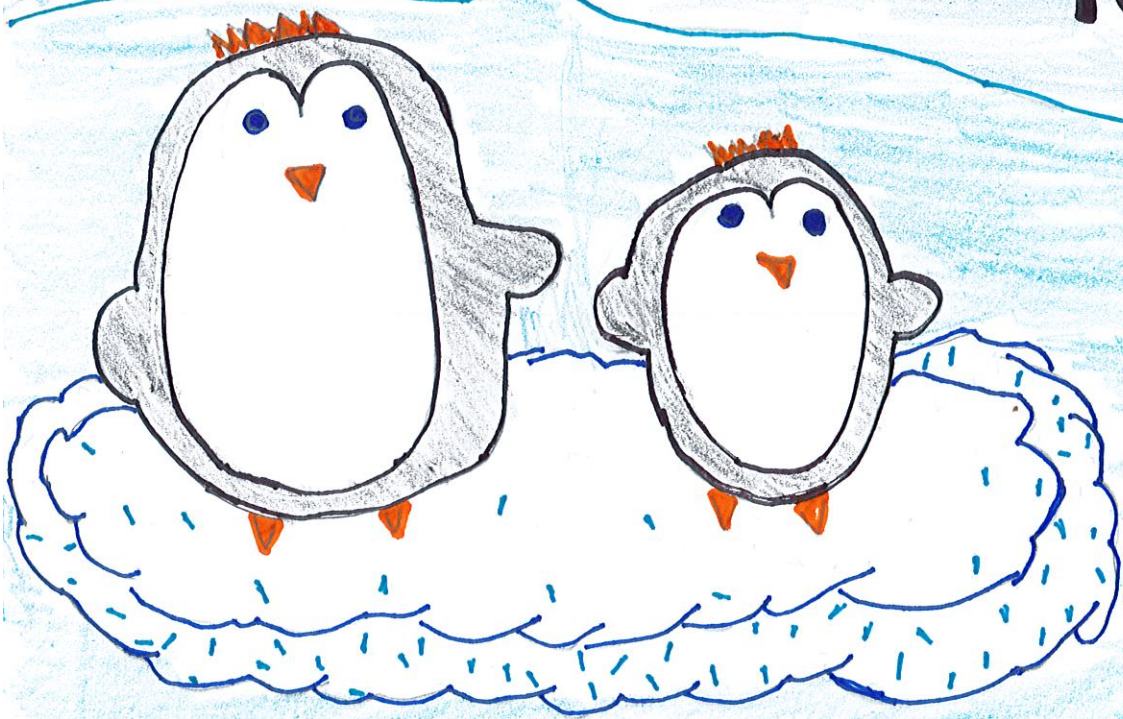


Flappy and Flop

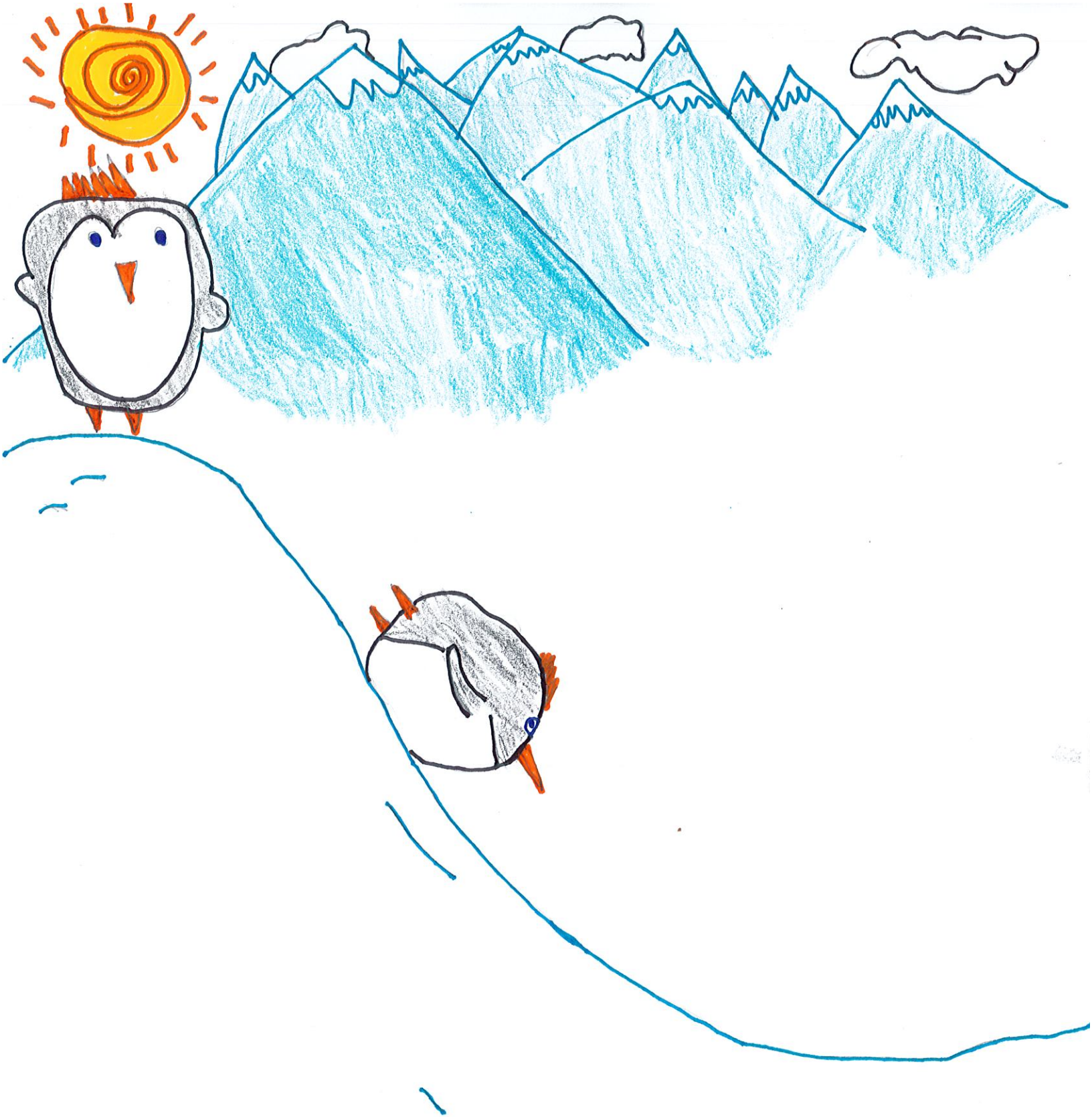

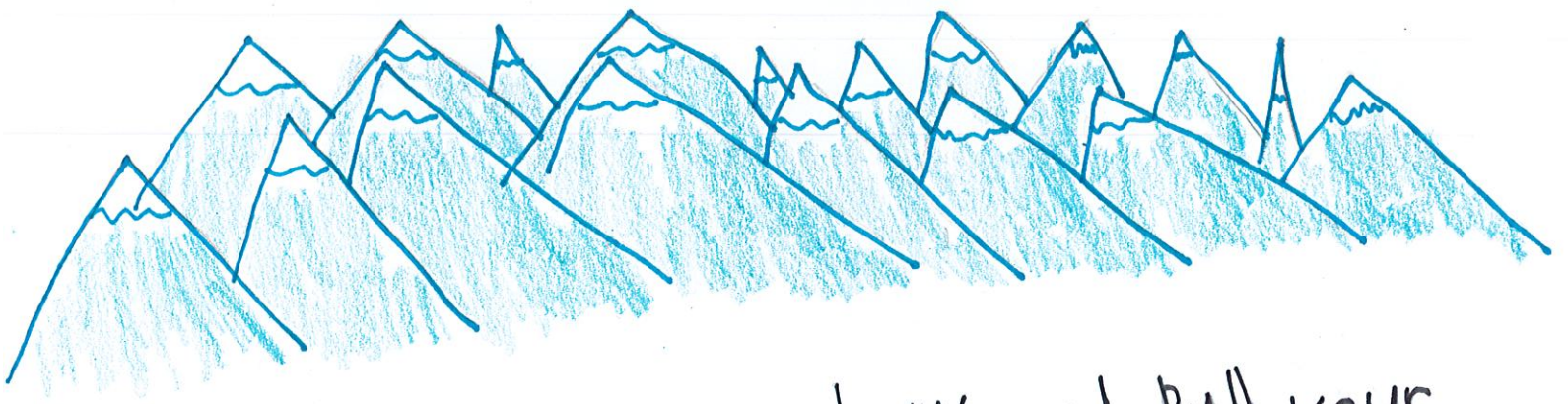


"Would you like to learn how to dive and slide down the snowy mountain?" asked Flappy.

"Yes, please," said Flop. "I'm excited to learn how to dive and slide down the snowy mountain!" Flop jumped up and down and turned around.

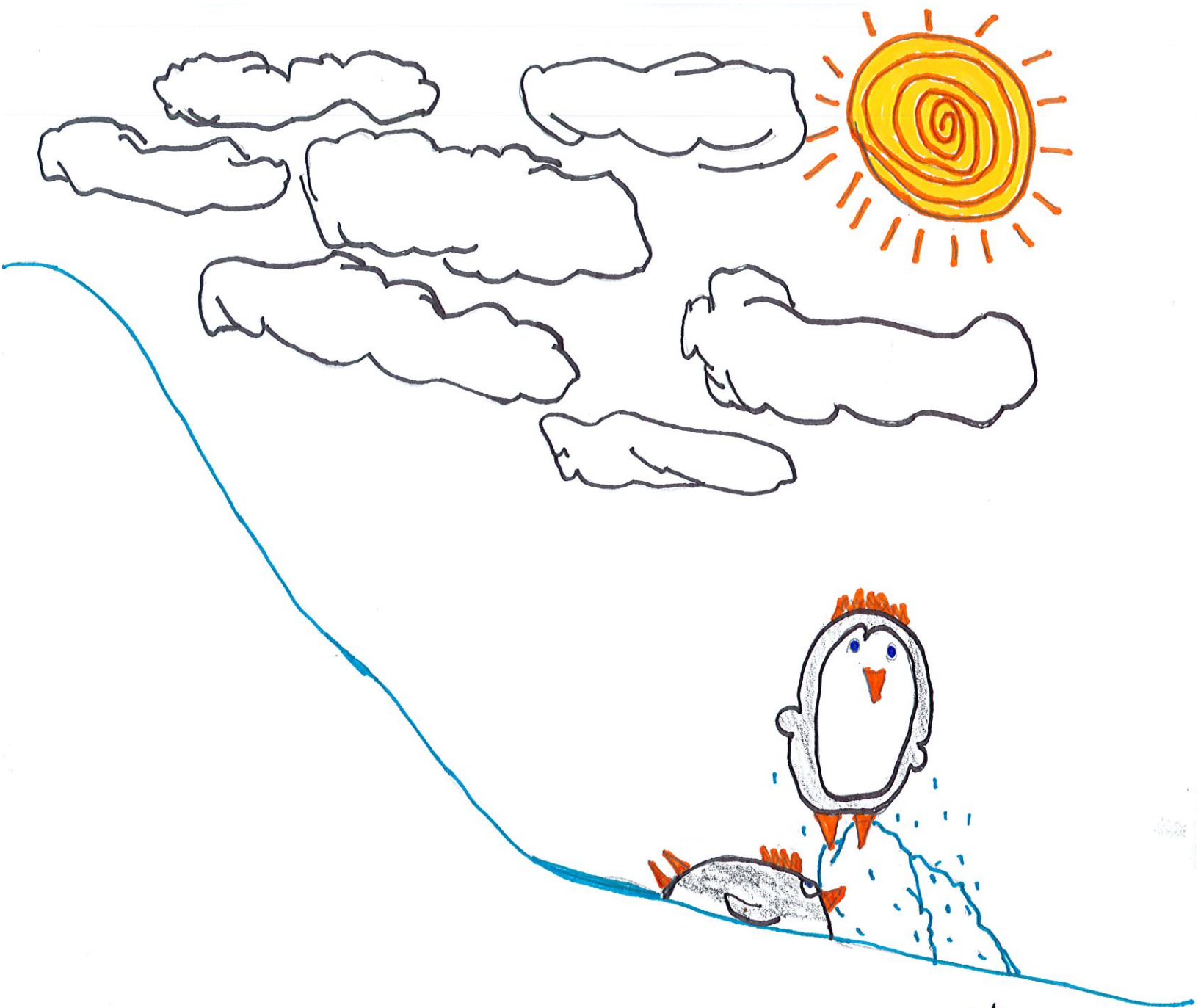
"Let's go!" said Flop. They waddled up the big, big snowy mountain.





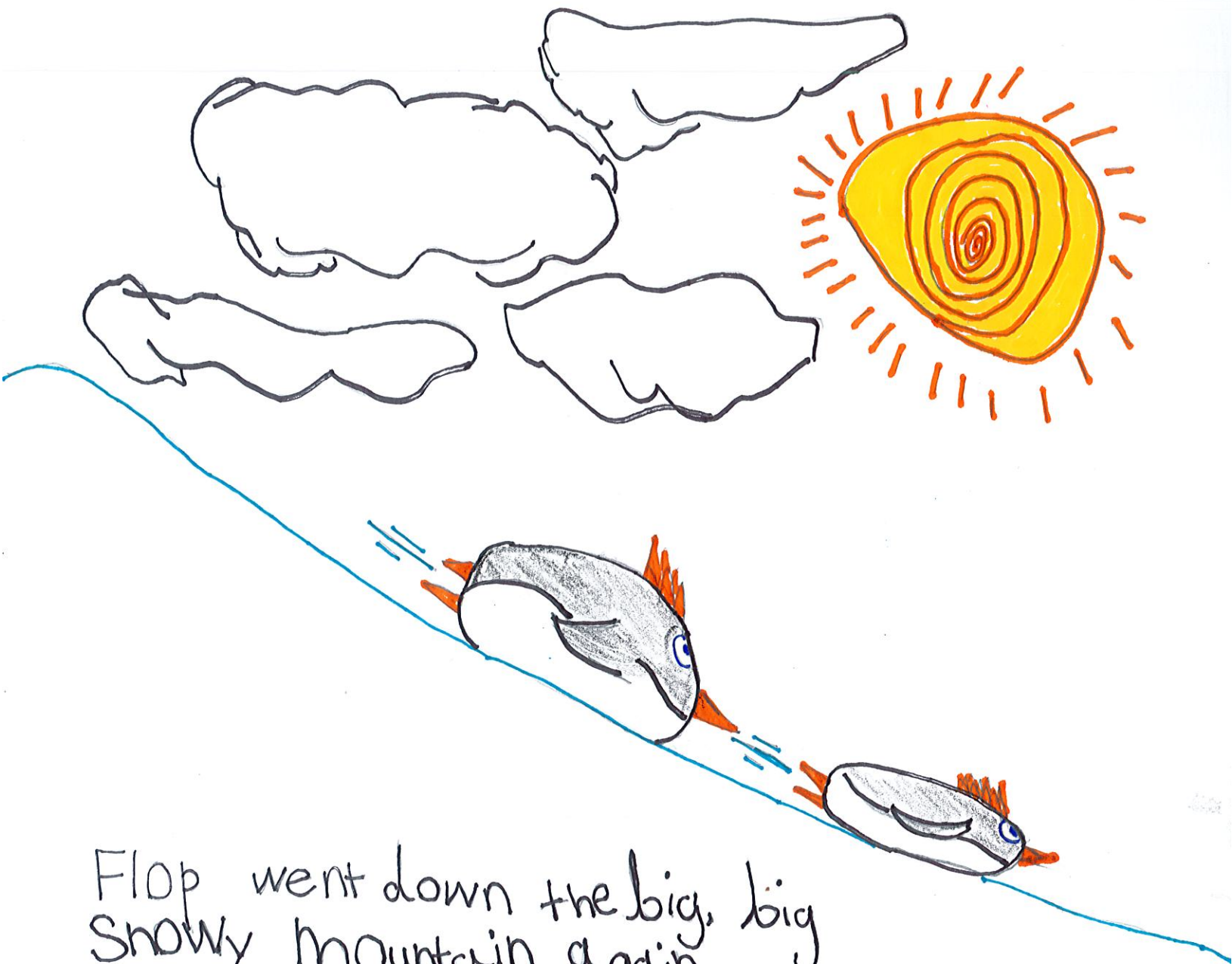
"First get on your belly and pull your wings back. Let go, and don't let your wings touch the ground," said Flappy.
