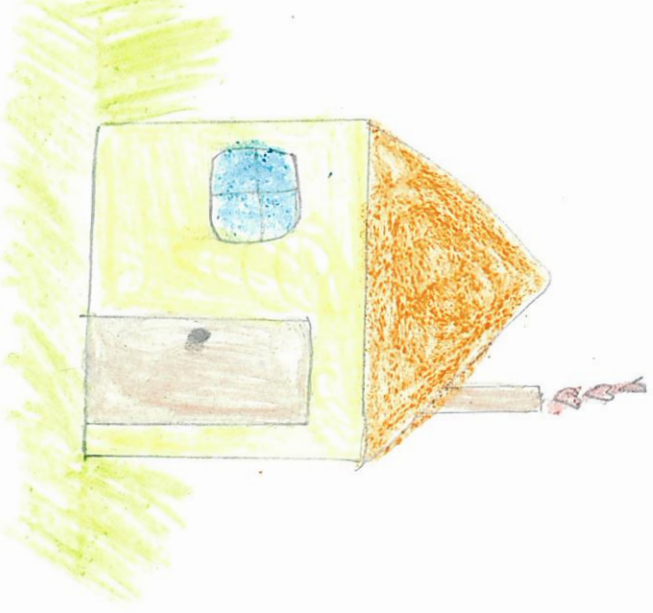


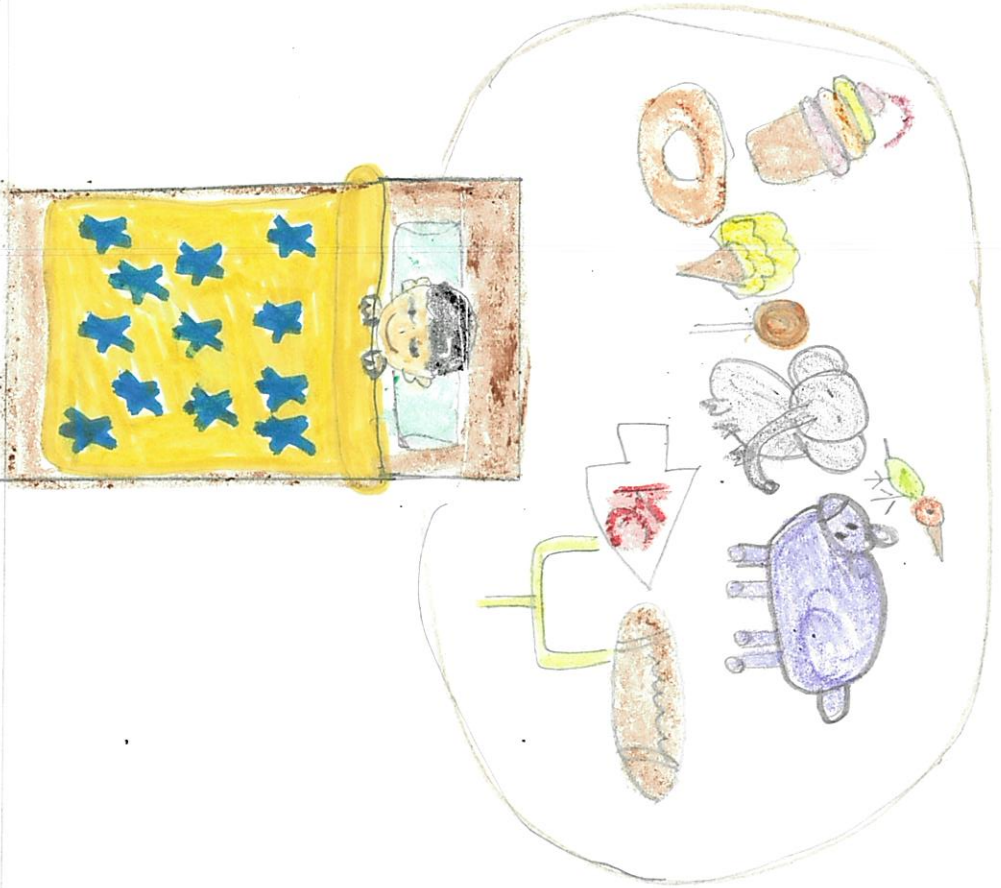

store was a 6 year old boy with big imagination. one night, he thought about all the places he wanted to visit and fell asleep.

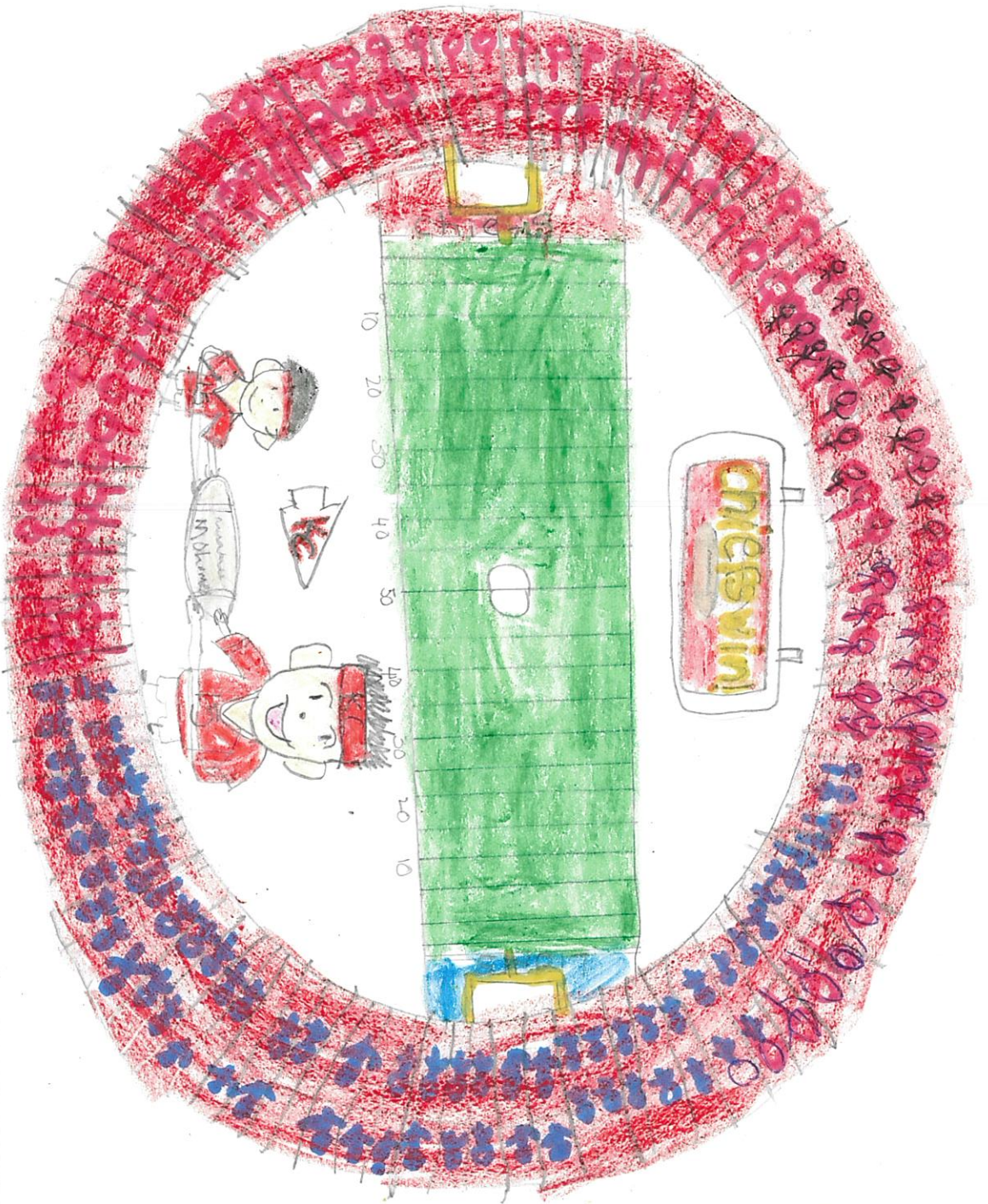


IN his dream, Steve traveled first to Candy Land.

Steve ate candy and bring some for his sister.

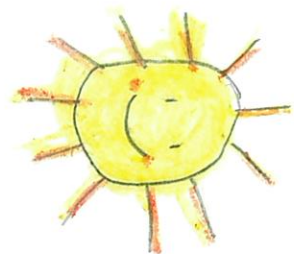
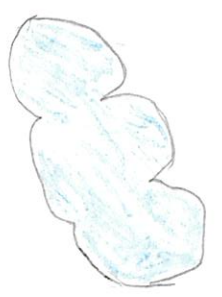


Next Steve went to the safari. He saw an elephant, the
